- MEXICO** is a single origin coffee, medium roast, full-bodied, rich with notes of chocolate, toffee, and a bright finish.
- PM** is a decaf blend that is hearty, buttery, and full-bodied. The caffeine is absent, but the flavor is not.

This unique and profitable fund-raising program can generate substantial funds for your program while also providing your supporters an opportunity to experience fresh, roasted, 100% organic coffee from an all-organic coffee roaster. Black Coffee sources ethically-produced beans and roasts with a great attention to detail; highlighting the years of work that go into a coffee bean before it reaches the customer. From the very beginning, Black Coffee has helped support numerous community groups and schools, and we here at EPI are excited to partner with them!

### **HOW IT WORKS:** Simple. Easy. Fresh

Black Coffee Roasting Company provides EPI with coffee at whole sale cost. Students are then able to sell the coffee at retail cost. The difference is then credited towards student tuition. EPI will provide the order forms. Students or groups can collect orders and payments from friends, family, and other supporters – students can go door to door, set up a stand at community events, or come up with their own unique ways to spread the word.

**Designate a coffee fundraiser Guru.** This person will be responsible for collecting all order forms and payments. They will encourage students to keep a list of what coffee they sold and to whom. The Guru will then submit the order forms to EPI along with a single payment for the total combined amount. All orders and payments must be submitted to EPI prior to the final payment deadline for the course.

**EPI must receive full payment with order forms** when they are submitted. Orders can be sent to EPI at the address below. Payment must be made out to Ecology Project International. Student accounts will be credited once EPI receives the order form(s) and payment. Black Coffee will have the order ready for shipment within 5 business days. Coffee will be sent in one box, which can then be distributed to your customers!

\*For every bag of coffee a student sells at \$13/bag, that student receives a tuition credit of \$5
